Purpose:	To provide an outline for the use of Class A uniforms for all positions of the fire department.		

Guideline:

All Class A dress uniforms shall be purchased through The Uniform Shoppe, located in Green Bay. All insignia should be purchased through Galls, Inc., Eagle Engraving or Point Trophy.

The uniforms shall consist of:

- 1. One pair of plain, pocket less pants
 - Honor Guard shall have 1 gold stripe along the hem of the pant leg.
- 2. One Navy, double-breasted 6 button jacket with coordinating banding around the sleeve cuff and coordinating button color.
 - Chief 5 gold stripes, gold buttons
 - Deputy Chief 4 gold stripes, gold buttons
 - Assistant Chief 3 gold stripes, gold buttons
 - Captain 2 gold stripes, gold buttons
 - Lieutenant 1 gold stripe, gold buttons
 - Honor Guard 2 gold stripes, gold buttons
 - All others no stripes, silver buttons
- 3. One long sleeve dress shirt
 - Chief, Deputy Chief, Assistant Chiefs and Honor Guard white
 - All others Light bule
- 4. One bell crown hat
 - Chief, Deputy Chief and Assistant Chiefs White with gold band and gold hat badge
 - Captain, Lieutenant and Honor Guard Navy with gold band and gold hat badge
 - All others Navy with black band and silver hat badge
- 5. Belt
 - Black leather with coordinating gold or silver buckle
 - No graphic belt buckles allowed
- 6. Shoes & Socks
 - Black, high gloss shoes
 - Black dress socks
- 7. Gloves
 - White (to be worn on special occasions determined by OIC)
- 8. Tie
 - Black clip on, single or double Windsor knot or ladies style

Patches

- 1. Patches for Class A uniform shall be as follows:
 - 1 department patch on the left sleeve
 - 1 reverse American flag on the right shoulder
 - Patches to be centered on the sleeve, 1 inch from the top hem.
 - Patches should be the same on the long sleeve shirt and the jacket
 - A rocker patch may be approved by the chief to designate Honor Guard affiliation
